



KING SOLOMON'S ROYAL ROBE

The kids are learning that we can be royal like King Solomon when we ask God to help us know what is right. They will each make their own royal robe to help remember this famous king who asked God for wisdom to help him know what was right!



DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print out one Royal Robe printable per child on legal size cardstock paper.
2. Cut out the printable and punch two holes in each robe; one at each shoulder.
3. Cut 12" pieces of yarn (2 per child) and tie one end of each piece on each hole.
4. Gather crayons, Royal Robes, and crayons for the leaders.

MAKE

1. Give each child their own Royal Robe printable to color.
2. As the kids color, discuss the talking points with them and recall the Bible story and the Big Idea together: *I can be royal like King Solomon when I ask God to help me know what is right.*
3. When they are finished coloring, help the kids tie their royal robe around their neck. As you do, say something like *[Child's name], you can be royal like King Solomon, too, when you ask God to help you know what is right.*
4. With their robes complete, have fun pretending to be royalty together – not just like any king and queen, but they can be royal like King Solomon by asking for wisdom.
