



KING XERXES ROYAL SCEPTER

The kids are learning that we can be royal like Queen Esther when we choose to do what is right. They will each make their own King Xerxes royal scepter to help remember the story of Queen Esther who was brave and chose to do what was right!



DIRECTIONS

PREP

1. Print out one set of Royal Scepter printables per child.
2. Cut out the printables.
3. Cut 12" pieces of ribbon.
4. Gather Royal Scepter printables, craft sticks, ribbon, tape, and crayons for the leaders.

MAKE

1. Give each child their own Royal Scepter printable for them to color.
2. As the kids color, discuss the talking points with them and recall the Bible story and the Big Idea together: *I can be royal like Queen Esther when I choose to do what is right.*
3. When they are finished coloring, help the kids tape the two sides of their scepters to a craft stick.
4. Give each child ribbon to tie to their scepters.
5. With their scepters complete, have fun pretending to be royalty together – not just like any king and queen, but they can be royal like Queen Esther by being brave and choosing to do what is right.
