DARING FAITH TELESCOPE

This week we are learning about the Bible story of Noah. In this story, Noah had to believe what God told him even though he did not understand. When we look up at the sky at night, it is hard to see that those dots are stars. But we believe they are because people who study space have seen them through telescopes. Now, let's make a telescope to remind us that we can believe even when we do not understand just like Noah!

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print the telescope wrapper printable onto white paper and cut out.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Distribute coloring medium to each table.
2. Give one telescope wrapper to each child and help them write their name on it.
3. Invite the children to color their telescope wrapper.
4. Remind the children of the teaching objective while they color and talk with them about situations where they can believe even when they do not understand.
5. When each child is done, attach the wrapper to the tube with tape or glue.

**Provide other craft mediums such as foam star stickers to provide the opportunity for additional creativity.*
