



## MY MIGHTY PRAYER BOOK

## DIRECTIONS

### PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out the My Mighty Prayer Book printable on white cardstock.
2. Cut out My Mighty Prayer Book and fold in half.

### DURING THE SERVICE

1. Distribute crayons to each table.
2. Give one My Mighty Prayer Book to each child and help them write their name on the bottom of the inside of the card.
3. Invite the children to color their card.
4. While the children are coloring, go around and help them come up with ideas of situations/people that they can draw/write.

*\*Get creative:* Provide stickers, glitter glue or other craft supplies to decorate the cover of the My Mighty Prayer Book.
